
New Deputy Principal at Padworth

We are delighted that Rebecca Clyde has now started at Padworth. Rebecca joins us from Cardiff Sixth Form College (CSFC), where she was Deputy Head – Academic Studies and Outreach, responsible for all teaching, learning and assessment.

During her time at CSFC, the College was rated as the top school in the UK in The Daily Telegraph and The Times A Level league tables, with 99% of students achieving A*-A grade in 2021. It was also awarded the top GCSE school in the UK in the small schools' league tables for GCSE in 2019.

At Padworth, Rebecca will work closely with Lorraine Atkins, Principal, with responsibility for all teaching and learning and assessments. She is also involved in the pastoral aspects of College life and as a resident of Padworth College, is part of the Boarding and Safeguarding Team.

Covid-19 Update

Whilst some of the restrictions relating to the global pandemic remain in place, we very much hope that we will be able to operate as close to normal as possible over the course of the Autumn Term and for the remainder of the academic year.

Nonetheless, we continue to remain vigilant and will adapt our day-to-day routines, as appropriate.

As you are aware, the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine has been authorised for use in persons aged 12 years and over in the UK. Last month, The Department of Health and Social Care confirmed that all young people aged 16 to 17 in England are to be offered a first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, whilst this week, the UK Government confirmed that one dose of the vaccine will be offered to all children aged 12 to 15 years.

We would prefer all students at the College to be vaccinated and would envisage that they should be able to receive both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine over the course of the Autumn Term. Last week, we wrote to parents of all students to seek their permission for their child to be vaccinated in the UK.

Students Celebrate Impressive Exam Results

Last month, we were delighted to share details of a terrific set of A Level results for our Year 13 students. Overall, 78% of grades awarded were A*-B, while 59% of all grades achieved were A*-A grade.

Autumn Term Events

Looking ahead to the remainder of this term, we have a busy calendar of events scheduled, including the International Student University Fair. This event, which is being organised by BSA, BAISIS and UK Education Guide, is running virtually on Wednesday 29 September 2021. The Fair will offer the following:

- More than 20 UK universities including University of Cambridge, University of Exeter, University of Southampton and University College London at virtual booths to meet prospective students individually and to answer their questions.
- Presentations addressing key challenges faced by international students and schools, including Q&A sessions with current international undergraduates and reviews of course options.
- 1:1 high quality advisory sessions for students on topics such as Personal Statement development, IELTS and general university advice.

All Year 13 students, including those on the NCUK IFY programme will be invited to attend.

In terms of other activities, in light of ongoing travel restrictions associated with coronavirus, we will again be organising a Half Term Programme during the Autumn

Term. Further details to follow.
