Padworth College is a boarding and day school for British and international students with a strong focus on preparation for university.

Occupying a 12 acre campus in Reading, just 50 miles from central London, Padworth provides easy access to many of the UK's leading universities, with more than 35 universities located less than 50 miles from the College, including 7 Russell Group universities.

Padworth College offers a unique educational experience and provides a stepping stone between traditional school education and university studies. Students are closely supervised and supported, but also learn how to study independently and to develop study skills that will allow them to thrive in a university environment.

The NCUK International Foundation Year

The NCUK International Foundation Year (IFY) is a modular programme that prepares students for first-year entry to undergraduate degree courses. Students will study a combination of modules that fit in with their degree destination with four pathways available: Business, Engineering, Humanities and Science.

All NCUK qualifications also include a specialist English for Academic Purposes module designed to give students the language ability and study skills that will give them a head start on their undergraduate degrees in the UK.

Successful completion of the IFY provides guaranteed access to one of over 40 NCUK Universities. Progression options include The University of Manchester, University of Exeter and University of Bristol, as well as a number of high-ranking universities in the UK and worldwide. **

GLOBAL STUDENT PROGRAMME

Once you have passed your NCUK International Foundation Year, you have a world of choice in front of you. NCUK programmes are widely recognised around the globe, with many international students progressing to the best universities in the UK, the US, New Zealand, Australia and the rest of the world.



ASSESSMENT

The IFY qualification consists of 70% Examination and 30% coursework. Assessments are quality assured by NCUK, with certificates issued by NCUK.

UCAS APPLICATIONS

To enable our students to apply to high quality universities, including Medical, Law and Engineering programmes by 15 October 2021, UCAS support is offered from the start of term in September.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Academic completion of 12 years of schooling (or local equivalent to meet the same standard) with good grades
- English: IELTS 5.5, with 5.0 in any band. Other English language levels may be accepted. Highly academically qualified students with an overall IELTS of 5.5 will be considered on a case-by-case basis



The Business Pathway prepares you in a variety of subject areas and offers a wide range of progression options, particularly if your interests are in business, finance and all areas of management. This is a great option if you are interested in studying Maths as one of your modules and wish to keep your options open to both Business and Humanities degrees.
