

English as Additional Language Teacher

Padworth College is seeking to appoint a full-time or part-time English as an Additional Language ('EAL') Teacher to deliver a range of English language courses onsite to students aged from 14 to 19 years old.

We are expanding our provision to offer an additional pre-sessional programme, supporting students who need to improve their English before progressing to study GCSEs, A Levels or Foundation programmes.

Teachers act as tutors, working with students to set academic targets and supporting them to achieve these targets. Teachers also take on a significant responsibility for the safeguarding and welfare of students.

Experience and Qualifications

We require a degree level qualification and a CELTA or equivalent qualification as minimum. Candidates must be able to demonstrate good organisational skills, precision in lesson planning and confident, enthusiastic classroom delivery. Experience of teaching Cambridge English exams is desirable, as is experience of working in a busy department where expectations of both students and teachers are high.

Terms

Job Title: Teacher of EAL

Reporting to: Co-Head of EAL, Deputy Principal (Academic) and Principal

Salary: This will be based on the Padworth College scale and will depend on qualifications and experience. Teachers will also be part of the College's pension scheme.

Hours of work: The teaching load is up to 24 hours per week. The College day is from 8.30am to 4.45pm and has 8 teaching periods of 45 minutes. Timetabled teaching is from Monday to Friday. In addition, teachers are expected to work one evening per week until 8.15pm supporting prep and 2 Sundays per term (from 9.00am to 6.00pm).

Contract: This is a full-time or part-time post, effective September 2023.

Medical Fitness: The offer of appointment at Padworth College will be conditional upon the provision of a self-declaration of physical and mental fitness to discharge responsibilities of the role.

Teachers are required to carry out general duties and responsibilities in addition to their teaching and pastoral responsibilities.

Lunch is provided free of charge on days of work.
