

Short Immersion Programme

Our short immersion programmes provide intensive English tuition, a taste of boarding, a personalised timetable and optional sightseeing. The benefit for students who move far away from home for the first time is that they can experience what it is like to live abroad in a safe and caring environment.

The Fees do NOT include:

Exam fees (GCSE, A Levels, IELTS, etc.), specialised study materials (e.g. art), stationery, student visa, guardianship, medical insurance, travel insurance, pocket money, optional sightseeing packages;

Airport transfers other than from and to Heathrow incur an extra charge of £35 per journey.

Sightseeing Packages

Optional sightseeing packages are available upon request. These packages need to be booked in advance of arrival and maximum one per week.

London: £80/pp

- Sightseeing Tour: Tower of London and Tower Bridge, Buckingham Palace, St. Paul's Cathedral, Westminster Abbey, Big Ben, Palace of Westminster, Kensington Palace, London Eye, Harrods, etc. (the detailed tour will vary and depend on the group and the weather conditions)
- Shopping: time to discover the best shopping in London – Oxford Street, Regent Street, Bond Street, Covent Garden, etc.
- Transport: by train and tube

Bath: £60/pp

- Discover historic Bath with a tour to the Roman Baths
- Experience culture with a visit to the Royal Theatre – one of the oldest theatres in the country
- Shopping
- Transport: by minibus

Portsmouth: £60/pp

- Visit Portsmouth's Historic Dockyard – home to a collection of historic ships and museums and the only place in the world to see the Royal Navy past, present and future
- Sightseeing: HMS Victory (famous warship in the Battle of Trafalgar), The Mary Rose (a Tudor Masterpiece and Henry VIII's true love), HMS M.33 (British warship from World War I), The National Museum of the Royal Navy (experience the historic battle of Jutland 1916), Royal Navy Submarine Museum, Explosion Museum of Naval Firepower, Harbour Tours, etc. (the detailed tour will vary and depend on the group and the weather conditions)
- Transport: by minibus

Admissions Process

Step 1: Application

- Go on our Admissions Portal: padworth.openapply.com
- Click “Start Your Application”
- Fill in the Application Form
- Upload copy of school reports: two most recent final or mid-term reports
- Upload the English Test
- Fill in the Personal Statement Form
- Upload copy of passport
- Fill in the Medical Form

Format of documents: The Application is to be completed in English and all documents must be in English. In most cases, unofficial translations are sufficient. School reports may require an explanation if no legend is provided. Please upload documents in **PDF format!**

Note: Submission of the application does not constitute acceptance and the offer of a place. Please submit all necessary supporting documents. We will only process the enrolment once all documents have been submitted in the correct format and the Application Fee has been paid.

Step 2: Offer of a Place and Acceptance

After successfully completing the application, the assessment and submitting all supporting documents, we will offer you a place. On receipt of an offer, you will be sent our School Contract. In order to accept an offer you will be required to countersign the School Contract and pay the applicable School Fees. We will help all **international students (non-UK and non-EU)** with their Tier 4 student visa application.
